2 This document is part of a series of documents that provide a description of aspects of the Scheme and procedures applied under it. This document is of value to all participants under the Scheme, i.e., to anyone concerned with the development, procurement, or accreditation of IT systems for which security is a consideration, as well as those already involved in the Scheme, i.e., Scheme employees, evaluators, current customers, contractors, and security consultants.

1.1 Purpose

4 The purpose of this document is to define the charging models and services within the Scheme.

5 General information about the Scheme is published in Scheme publication SP-001 *Certification and Evaluation Scheme - Scheme Overview*.

6 Abbreviations commonly used by CSEC are described in SP-001 *Certification and Evaluation - Scheme Overview*.

2 Model

2.1 Charging Models

7 The certification and licensing services provided by the Certification Body according
to the Scheme are mostly provided at a fixed price rate. Some activities are charged on
an hourly basis.

8 The rates are established in this document. The rates are listed in Chapter 3, Services.
9 CSEC reserves the right to adjust the fees described. In such cases, justification will be
provided prior to the signing of any agreement.

2.2 Expenses

10 Expenses are charged only when travel outside of Stockholm is required. Charging of
expenses must be agreed to by the customer and will be conducted in accordance with
The Swedish Defense Materiel Administration (FMV) travel regulations.

11 Expenses include actual costs and a per diem compensation. The per diem
compensation is in accordance with the level for non-taxed compensation allowed by
the Swedish tax authority.

12 For travelling outside Sweden expenses are charged for actual costs, per diem
compensation and, when applicable, for any extra costs that CSEC will have due to
the travel.

13 CSEC reserves the right to assign one or more certifiers to a specific mission.

14 FMV travel regulations and a list of per diem compensations are available upon
request.

2.3 Value Added Tax

15 The Value Added Tax (VAT, Swedish: MOMS) will be added according to Swedish
Law.

2.4 Payment

16 Invoices are submitted according to quotation and agreement. The payment period is
30 days net.

17 No administrative costs are added.

18 Interest of overdue payment may be added in accordance with Swedish law.

19 Payment in other currencies than SEK can be accepted and shall be agreed upon
before invoicing.

3 Services

3.1 Licensing

The Certification Body will charge the fees listed in this section for activities related to licensing evaluation facilities. For further information about licensing activities, please see Scheme publication SP-004 *Licensing of Evaluation Facilities*.

<p>Licensing fee</p> <p>This fee refers to the costs of Certification Body assistance and assessment activities during the licensing process, from the evaluation facility's application until granting of a full IT Security Evaluation Facility (ITSEF) license. The fee includes the licensing effort during site visit at one site. The fee includes the licensing effort during the trial evaluation and is in addition to the fees charged to the Sponsor for the certification.</p> <p>If a licensing process is terminated, the licensing fee might be reduced, in relation to the actual costs of the Certification Body assistance.</p>	125 000 SEK
<p>Additional Site Visits and Extension of the License Scope</p> <p>Assessment and site visits for each additional evaluation facility location not included in the Licensing fee, see above.</p>	An hourly rate of 815 SEK
<p>Expenses</p> <p>Expenses (e.g. for travel) will be charged in accordance with section 2.2.</p>	In accordance with section 2.2.
<p>Yearly license fee</p>	25 000 SEK/year plus 10 000 SEK/year per site for more than two sites in Sweden and any site abroad

22 The certification fee is depending on complexity of the evaluated parts of the product to be certified and EAL-level. The complexity is estimated on a scale from A to D.

A	Simple IT products/protection profiles (PP) with limited scope
B	IT products/protection profiles of average size and complexity
C	Large and complex IT products/protection profiles
D	Very large and complex IT products/protection profiles

23 The classification of products into complexity classes A, B, C and D, will be made by the Certification Body and is based on the estimated work effort for the certification. Number of configurations and the complexity of the security functions will influence the judgement.

24 A similar classification is used for Protection Profiles.

25 In addition to the complexity class, EAL-level will influence the pricing. Addition of assurance class life-cycle support flaw remediation (ALC_FLR), when applicable, is included in the price for each level. Other augmentations may influence the price.

26 EAL 5 and above is priced for the individual certification, as is EAL 4 with extended augmentations.
